
Bellevue Features

- **Weekend:** \$35 for 18 holes with cart
- **Weekday:** \$29.25 for 18 holes with cart

In Season Rates (*May 1st to September 30th and prices are subject to HST*)


- **Weekend (morning tournament):** \$41 for 18 holes with cart
Weekend (morning tournament): \$38 for 18 holes with cart with tournament meal
- **Weekend (afternoon tournament):** \$38 for 18 holes with cart
Weekend (afternoon tournament): \$35 for 18 holes with cart with tournament meal
- **Weekday:** \$29.25 for 18 holes with cart

2019 Golf Specials

Tournaments or groups can also take advantage of our 2019 Golf Specials. Please note that the prices below are based on two players and are only valid in tee time format. Prices also do not include HST.

The Bellevue Special: Every day (Monday to Sunday) after 1pm, two players can play 18 holes with cart for \$55.

Twilite Special: Every Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday after 4:30pm or every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday after 5:30pm, two players can play unlimited golf with cart for \$45.



Value Packages

Bellevue Golf Club offers three different value packages in order to help you set your tournament apart from all the others. Also, because we are determined to make your event the best, we also provide an added bonus when a value package is purchased.

Value Package 1: Hot dog on the turn and a can beer - \$7 (15% savings)

Value Package 2: Range balls, hot dog, can beer and a bag of chips - \$12.50 (18% savings)

Value Package 3: Range balls, hot dog, can beer, bag of chips, a sleeve of Bellevue branded Callaway golf balls and a package of tees - \$21 (20% savings)

(Prices are subject to tax with Food and Beverage also being subject to 15% gratuities)


BONUS: Purchase anyone of our value packages and receive equal or greater value back in golf passes that can be used for your prize table or auctioned off to raise money for your charity. Each pass will include a foursome for 18 holes. Some restrictions apply. Each pass is valued at \$145.

How this works

If you had a 100 person tournament and decided to purchase Value Package 2, the cost for that package (including taxes and gratuities) would be \$1,532. This in turn would be the amount of money we use to determine how many golf passes to handout.

\$1,532 divide by \$145 (value of each pass) = 10.57 passes

Now since we like to round up, this means your tournament would receive 11 foursomes for 18 holes to be used at your prize table or to be auctioned off.



Tournament Meals and Dessert

Homemade Carrot Cake Desert **\$4.99pp**



Made with Bellevue's classic 6oz homemade patty, served with lettuce, tomato and onion and comes with fries and coleslaw.



Why do a golf tournament?


Many groups enjoy golf tournaments because they revolve around an outdoor activity that allows you to socialize as well as enjoy a little competition. Golf tournaments also prove to be a great way to fundraise due to the fact that in a single day they can produce thousands of dollars towards a known cause (consider the example below)

Example: A morning shot gun in the month of June with a steak dinner would cost \$68.92 per player. If you charged \$125 per player, then you would profit \$56.08 per player. If you had 144 golfers in your tournament, you would make \$8,075.52

This does not include any extra money you will have made through your putting green contest, PLINKO game, longest drive contest, closest to the pin competitions or any advertising signs you might have sold.

How to get started

- Sport teams and clubs have the most success putting on a golf tournament for the first time due to the fact that there are 15-30 people putting on the tournament as oppose to just one. If interested in putting a golf tournament together, find the right people to help.
- Once the appropriate helpers are found, select a suitable date for your outing as well as an alternative date.
- You should also determine what time of day you wish to tee off at as well as the approximate number of golfers who will play.
- Next, determine what food you would like to eat and whether or not you would like to add one of our Value Packages.
- Once these questions are answered call Bellevue to determine if the date and time chosen is open.

Once a date is booked.....

- Determine what price you would like to charge for your event. Most tournaments at Bellevue charge between \$100 and \$125 per player depending on the time of year, the total cost of the event and how much money would like to be raised.
- Once a price is determined then flyers and tickets need to be made to help advertise the event and give out to participating players. (**NOTE: Always collect the money up front, this ensures that you won't be held accountable for those who did not show up.**)
- Most tournaments like to give trophies/prizes to the winners of the tournament as well as door prizes for those who attended. Know that many businesses will donate prizes for golf tournaments.
- To generate even more revenue, you can also do tee sign advertising for local businesses. Most tournaments will charge between \$50 to \$100 per sign.

Advice for Annual Events

- If this tournament is going to be an annual event, don't forget to create a contact list by collecting phone numbers/email addresses from those who participated in your tournament. This will help you grow your tournament year after year.
