2021 Tournament Rates (all rates are subject to HST)

- **Weekday:** \$33.75 for 18 holes with cart
- **Weekend Morning Start:** \$45 for 18 holes with cart
- **Weekend After 1pm Start:** \$35 for 18 holes with cart
- **Weekend Morning after September 30th:** \$40 for 18 holes with cart

NOTE: Due to Covid-19 and group gathering restrictions, Bellevue will not be offering shot gun starts for the 2021 season. All tournaments will follow a straight tee time format.

As seen in 2020, this can be beneficial since there is no maximum on how many players can play under a straight tee time format. A full shot gun is 144 players. Under a straight tee time format, many of our tournaments exceeded 180 players in 2020. This means more money going towards your known cause.

Value Packages

Bellevue Golf Club offers three different value packages in order to help you set your tournament apart from all the others.

Value Package 1: Hot dog on the turn and a can beer - \$8 (5% savings)

Value Package 2: Range balls, hot dog, can beer and a bag of chips - \$14.75 (10% savings)

Value Package 3: Range balls, hot dog, can beer, bag of chips, a sleeve of Callaway golf balls and a package of tees - \$24.25 (15% savings)

(Prices are subject to tax with Food and Beverage also being subject to 15% gratuities)



Tournament Meals

Due to Covid-19, we do anticipate operating under some form of restrictions for the majority of the 2021 golf season. This means that the banquet facility may or may not be available this year.

We do, however, anticipate being able to use our outside patio for the majority of the year. Under the Green, Yellow and Orange Public Health and Workplace Safety Measures, we are allowed group gathering of up to 100 people outside.

Our current patio can hold 80 people. Since shot gun starts are not allowed, we don't have to worry about 144 people coming off the course all at once. With straight tee times, players will be coming off gradually and due to us being able to accommodate 80 people, this will allow players up to 2 hours to eat and socialize after their round.

If restrictions were to fall into the Red Control category (25 people outside) players would have up to 40 minutes to eat and socialize after their round. This time limit is given in order to accommodate the rest of the tournament players coming off the course while not exceeding gathering limits.

Due to the above information, we have modified our menu options for the 2021 golf season.

Cheeseburger Deluxe

\$13.99pp

Made with Bellevue's classic 6oz homemade patty, served with lettuce, tomato and onion and comes with fries and coleslaw.

Chicken and Penne Dinner

\$18.99pp

Two 5oz chicken breast lightly seasoned and grilled to perfection, served with penne and garlic bread.

Ribs and Fries

\$21.99pp

A full rack of specially seasoned fall off the bone ribs, served with fries and coleslaw.

(All tournament meals are subject to HST and 15% gratuities)

Why do a golf tournament?

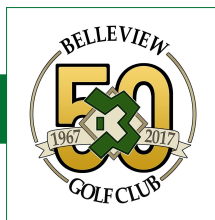
Many groups enjoy golf tournaments because they revolve around an outdoor activity that allows you to socialize as well as enjoy a little competition. Golf tournaments also prove to be a great way to fundraise due to the fact that in a single day they can produce thousands of dollars towards a known cause (consider the example below)

Example: A morning tournament in the month of June with a cheese burger deluxe would cost \$69.03 per player. If you charged \$125 per player, then you would profit \$55.97 per player. If you had 144 golfers in your tournament, you would make \$8,059.68

This does not include any extra money you will have made through your putting green contest, PLINKO game, longest drive contest, closest to the pin competitions or any advertising signs you might have sold.

How to get started

- Sport teams and clubs have the most success putting on a golf tournament for the first time due to the fact that there are 15-30 people putting on the tournament as oppose to just one. If interested in putting a golf tournament together, find the right people to help.
- Once the appropriate helpers are found, select a suitable date for your outing as well as an alternative date.
- You should also determine what time of day you wish to tee off at as well as the approximate number of golfers who will play.
- Next, determine what food you would like to eat and whether or not you would like to add one of our Value Packages.
- Once these questions are answered call Bellevue to determine if the date and time chosen is open.

Once a date is booked.....

- Determine what price you would like to charge for your event. Most tournaments at Bellevue charge between \$100 and \$125 per player depending on the time of year, the total cost of the event and how much money would like to be raised.
- Once a price is determined then flyers and tickets need to be made to help advertise the event and give out to participating players. (**NOTE: Always collect the money up front, this ensures that you won't be held accountable for those who did not show up.**)
- Most tournaments like to give trophies/prizes to the winners of the tournament as well as door prizes for those who attended. Know that many businesses will donate prizes for golf tournaments.
- To generate even more revenue, you can also do tee sign advertising for local businesses. Most tournaments will charge between \$50 to \$100 per sign.

Advice for Annual Events

- If this tournament is going to be an annual event, don't forget to create a contact list by collecting phone numbers/email addresses from those who participated in your tournament. This will help you grow your tournament year after year.
