## COVID-19 POLICIES

**Policies are subject to change. Please review before EVERY tee time to ensure you are compliant.**

All Players are responsible to read, know and adhere to the following covid-19 policies.

Any players **NOT** adhering to the following policies may face....

1. A warning
2. Asked to leave without refund
3. Have Police contacted



Do **NOT** enter the premise if:

- You have had a cough, fever, or are experiencing flu like symptoms
- You have travelled outside Canada in the last 14 days
- You have had contact with someone who has had flu-like symptoms or has travelled outside Canada in the last 14 days

## Checking In Process: Grey Lockdown/Provincial Shutdown

All golfers must be at the golf course at least 15 minutes before their tee time. Late players will be sent home. Extra players will be sent home.

- **25 minutes before your tee time:** This is the earliest any player can come prior to their tee time unless they are going to use the driving range. Before entering the property, all players must check in with the **Greeter** or wait to be called in over the PA system. .
- **15 minutes before your tee time:** All players must be at the course and checking in for their tee time. Once checked in, players can load up their carts or proceed to the designated area for walkers. All players must stay on their carts or in the designated area until the group ahead has taken the tee. At this time players can use the putting green.
- **5 minutes before your tee time:** Take the tee and get ready to tee off.

## Checking In Process: Red Public Health Measure

All golfers must be at the golf course at least 15 minutes before their tee time. Late players will be sent home. Extra players will be sent home.

- **45 minutes before your tee time:** This is the earliest any player can come prior to their tee time. Players can enter the property, check in for their tee time and go to the range if they wish to do so.
- **15 minutes before your tee time:** All players must be at the course and checking in for their tee time. Once checked in, players can load up their carts or proceed to the designated area for walkers. All players must stay on their carts or in the designated area until the group ahead has taken the tee. At this time players can use the putting green.
- **5 minutes before your tee time:** Take the tee and get ready to tee off.

## Checking In Process: All other Public Health Measures

- Players can come any time before their tee time to use the practice facility.
- All players must be checked in and paid 15 minutes before their tee time
- All players must take the tee 5 minutes before their tee time or once the group ahead has left the tee.

## **Physical Distancing (2 meters or 6 feet apart) must be adhered to at all times**

This includes.....

- In the parking lot
- At the information sign (*look for spacing lines on the ground*)
- Checking in (*look for spacing lines on the ground*)
- On the putting green (*limit of 4 players*)
- On the course

### **No Group Gatherings are allowed**

- Players **CANNOT** congregate out on the course
- Players **CANNOT** congregate in the parking lot
- **Grey Lockdown/Provincial Shutdown:** All players must leave immediately after their round of golf.

### **The Clubhouse**

- The Clubhouse will remain closed until further notice with the exception of washrooms.
- In order to check-in, all players must proceed to the service window on the west side of the building (*facing the parking lot*)
- There will be another service window by the 10<sup>th</sup> tee for turn items and take out.
- **NO CASH WILL BE EXCEPTED**

### **Washrooms**

- All washrooms have been upgraded to be hands free with the exception of the toilets.
- All washrooms have a limit of 2 players per washroom and **mask MUST be worn when entering the building.**
- Please follow good hygiene practices when using the washroom

## On the golf course

- All **GOLF CARTS** must adhere to **90 degree rule** unless otherwise directed.
- All ball washers have been removed
- All bunker rakes have been removed (*please smooth the sand with your club or foot afterwards. Preferred lies are allowed in bunkers*)
- Pins have been modified to remove touch points on the cups and flags.

**NO PLAYER WILL BE ALLOWED TO TOUCH  
THE FLAG OR THE PIN AT ANY TIME.**

- Gimme's are encouraged
- The use of hand sanitizer after each hole is recommended.
- As always, replace divots, repair ball marks and adhere to all signage

## RENTALS

- Club Rentals are available.
- **Pull Carts are allowed.** Please leave the handle attached when finished, so that it can be disinfected and washed
- **Power Carts are allowed.** All players **must wear a mask when riding** in a power cart. Players must choose a side (driver/passenger) and must remain on that side for the entire round.

## Pace of Play

- To avoid gatherings out on the course due to **slow play AND fast play**, all players must play at a 4 hour to 4 hour 30 minute pace for 18 holes as recommended by the G.A.O. (*2 hours to 2 hours 15 minutes for 9 holes*)
- This means players will have 13 minutes to 15 minutes to play each hole
- Any players playing slower or faster will be encouraged to change their pace of play.
- Other measures may be taken if any group is not compliant.

## Food & Beverage | Restaurant

- Food and beverage can be purchased after checking in or on the turn from our service window located on the north side of the building (facing the 10<sup>th</sup> tee)
- The beverage cart is available on the course. Hours may vary.
- The outside patio is available depending on the current public health status. Please see “Outside Patio” for more information.

### Want your food ready for pick up on the 10<sup>th</sup> hole or after your round?

- Look for our pre-order signs on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> tee.
- All payments must be made by debit or credit
- **NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED**
- **ALL ALCOHOL PURCHASED OFF-SITE IS PROHIBITED UNDER PROVINCIAL LAW.**

## Outdoor Patio

- **Hours of Operation:** Monday to Friday - 11am to 8pm.  
Weekends - 10am to 8pm. Hours of operation are subject to change.
- The patio is reserved for those who wish to sit down after their round with their group and purchase food and/or beverages.
- We will still be operating with limited food choices
- All tables and chairs will be sanitized after each use
- All patrons must discard of their own garbage/recycle
- Please use the designated service window on the east side of the building to order.

## Outdoor Limits According to Public Health Zone.

**Green Public Health Measure:** ----- 100 people outside

**Yellow Public Health Measure:** ----- 100 people outside

**Orange Public Health Measure:** -----100 people outside

**Red Public Health Measure:** -----25 people outside

**Grey Public Health Measure:** -----No indoor or outdoor service.

**Ontario Shutdown** -----No indoor or outdoor service.

## Booking Tee Times

- Tee times can be booked by contacting the Proshop or booking online at [www.bellevuegolf.ca](http://www.bellevuegolf.ca)
- All payments done through the service window must be done by debit or credit. **TAP is encouraged**
- **NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED**
- Walking is encouraged
- Foursomes are encouraged,
- When necessary, twosomes or singles will be paired up.

## Driving Range

- **The driving range and putting green is reserved ONLY for those who have purchased a basket of balls.** Players with tee times can use the practice green next to the first tee once checked in.
- **Hours of Operation:** Range baskets can be purchased between the hours of 7am to 8pm on Saturday, Sunday & Holidays, 8am to 8pm Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday or 10am to 8pm Monday and Thursday. Hours of operation are subject to change due to weather, sunrise and sunset
- **Bucket Sizes:** Small, Medium and Large.
- Range Buckets can be purchased through our service window for the turn facing the 10<sup>th</sup> tee. **Before 11am range buckets must be purchased from our service window facing the parking lot**
- **Once finished, all players must place their range baskets in the designate pail for sanitization.**

## Tee Times and Driving Range

- Players with tee times can use the driving range during the hours of operation listed above. **Please follow check-in protocols.**
- All players can use the driving range until 15 minutes before their scheduled tee time.
