


BELLEVIEW GOLF CLUB COVID-19 POLICIES

Policies are subject to change. Please review before <u>EVERY</u> tee time to ensure you are compliant.

All Players are responsible to read, know and adhere to the following covid-19 policies.

Any players **NOT** adhering to the following policies may face....

- 1.A warning
- 2. Asked to leave without refund
- 3. Have Police contacted



Do **NOT** enter the premise if:

- You have had a cough, fever, or are experiencing flu like symptoms
- You have travelled outside Canada in the last 14 days
- You have had contact with someone who has had flu-like symptoms or has travelled outside Canada in the last 14 days

Checking In Process

All golfers must be at the golf course at least 15 minutes before their tee time. Late players will be sent home. Extra players will be sent home.

- 45 minutes before your tee time: This is the earliest any player can come prior to their tee time. Players can either enter the property to use the range or wait in their vehicle until 20 minutes before their tee time.
- 20 minutes before your tee time: Players can exit their vehicles and come to the greeting area.
- 15 minutes before your tee time: Players can enter the property from the parking lot to check in. Once checked in, players can load up their carts or proceed to the designated area for walkers. All players must stay on their carts or in the designated area until the group ahead has taken the tee. At this time players can use the putting green.
- 5 minutes before your tee time: Take the tee and get ready to tee off.

Physical Distancing (2 meters or 6 feet apart) must be adhered to at all times

This includes.....

- In the parking lot
- At the information sign (look for spacing lines on the ground)
- Checking in (look for spacing lines on the ground)
- On the putting green (limit of 4 players)
- On the course

No Group Gatherings are allowed

- Players **CANNOT** congregate out on the course
- All players must leave the property immediately after their round
- Players **CANNOT** congregate in the parking lot

The Clubhouse

- The Clubhouse will remain closed until further notice with the exception of washrooms.
- In order to check-in, all players must proceed to the service window on the west side of the building (facing the parking lot)
- There will be another service window by the 10th tee for turn items and take out.
- NO CASH WILL BE EXCEPTED

Washrooms

- All washrooms have been upgraded to be hands free with the exception of the toilets.
- All washrooms have a limit of 2 players per washroom
- Please follow good hygiene practices when using the washroom

On the golf course

- All GOLF CARTS must adhere to 90 degree rule unless otherwise directed.
- All ball washers have been removed
- All bunker rakes have been removed (please smooth the sand with your club or foot afterwards. Preferred lies are allowed in bunkers)
- Pins have been modified to remove touch points on the cups and flags.

NO PLAYER WILL BE ALLOWED TO TOUCH THE FLAG OR THE PIN AT ANY TIME.

- Gimme's are encouraged
- The use of hand sanitizer after each hole is recommended.
- · As always, replace divots, repair ball marks and adhere to all signage

RENTALS

- No Club Rentals
- Pull Carts are allowed. Please leave the handle attached when finished, so that it can be disinfected and washed
- Power Carts are allowed. Dividers have been installed into all of the carts for double occupancy. Players are must choose a side (driver/passenger) and must remain on that side for the entire round.

Pace of Play

- To avoid gatherings out on the course due to slow play AND fast play, all players must play at a 4 hour to 4 hour 30 minute pace for 18 holes as recommended by the G.A.O. (2 hours to 2 hours 15 minutes for 9 holes)
- This means players will have 13 minutes to 15 minutes to play each hole
- Any players playing slower or faster will be encouraged to change their pace of play.
- Other measures may be taken if any group is not compliant.

Food & Beverage | Restaurant

- Food and beverages can be purchased when checking in from our pro shop service window
- Food and beverages can be purchased on the turn from our service window located on the north side of the building (facing the 10th tee)
- Food and beverages can be purchased after your round for take-out.

Want your food ready for pick up on the 10th hole or after your round?

- Look for our pre-order signs on the 9th and 18th tee.
- You can place an order by phone or make an order online
- NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED
- All payments must be made by debit or credit
- <u>ALL ALCOHOL PURCHASED OFF-SITE IS PROHIBITED UNDER PROVINCIAL LAW.</u>

Booking Tee Times

- Tee times can be booked by contacting the Proshop or booking online
- Players will have the option of pre-paying by phone or internet or paying at the course through our service window.
- NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED
- All payments done through the service window must be done by debit or credit using <u>TAP</u>
- Walking is encouraged
- Foursomes are encouraged,
- When necessary, twosomes will be paired up.

Driving Range

- The driving range and putting green is reserved ONLY for those who have purchased a basket of balls. Players with tee times can use the practice green next to the first tee once checked in.
- Hours of Operation: Range baskets can be purchased between the hours of 12pm to 7:30pm Monday to Friday or 10am to 7:30pm Saturday and Sunday. Hours of operation are subject to change.
- Bucket Sizes: Small, Medium and Large.
- Putting Green: A maximum of 8 people are allowed on the putting green
- Range Buckets can be purchased through our service window for the turn facing the 10th tee.
- Once finished, all players must place their range basket in the designate pail for sanitization.

Tee Times and Driving Range

- Players with tee times can use the driving range during the hours of operation listed above. Please follow check-in protocol.
- Players may purchase a range bucket from the designated service window but cannot check in for their tee time.
- All players can use the driving range until 15 minutes before their scheduled tee time.
- All players are to return to the greeting area to be checked in with the rest of their tee time.

Outdoor Patio

• Belleview is part of the Town of Kingsville and is unable to open the outdoor patio at this time.
