## COVID-19 POLICIES

**Policies are subject to change. Please review before EVERY tee time to ensure you are compliant.**

All Players are responsible to read, know and adhere to the following covid-19 policies.

Any players **NOT** adhering to the following policies may face....

1. A warning
2. Asked to leave without refund
3. Have Police contacted



Do **NOT** enter the premise if:

- You have had a cough, fever, or are experiencing flu like symptoms
- You have travelled outside Canada in the last 14 days
- You have had contact with someone who has had flu-like symptoms or has travelled outside Canada in the last 14 days

## Checking In Process: Stage 3 of Ontario's Reopening Plan

All golfers must be at the golf course at least 15 minutes before their tee time. Late players will be sent home. Extra players will be sent home.

- **30 minutes before your tee time:** This is the recommended time of arrival for all players. **Players that want to use the driving range are encouraged to arrive 45 to 60 minutes before their tee time.**
- **15 minutes before your tee time:** All players must be at the course and checking in for their tee time. Once checked in, players can load up their carts or proceed to the designated area for walkers. All players must stay on their carts or in the designated area until the group ahead has taken the tee. At this time players can use the putting green.
- **5 minutes before your tee time:** Take the tee and get ready to tee off.

## Physical Distancing (2 meters or 6 feet apart) must be adhered to at all times

This includes.....

- In the parking lot
- Checking in (*look for spacing lines on the ground*)
- On the putting green (*limit of 4 players*)
- On the course

## No Group Gatherings are allowed

- Players **CANNOT** congregate out on the course
- Players **CANNOT** congregate in the parking lot

## The Clubhouse

- Due to renovations occurring to the Pro Shop and Lounge, the Clubhouse will remain closed until further notice with the exception of washrooms.
- In order to check-in, all players must proceed to the service window on the west side of the building (*facing the parking lot*)
- There will be another service window by the 10<sup>th</sup> tee for turn items and take out.
- Debit and credit is preferred. Cash is accepted.

## Washrooms

- All washrooms have been upgraded to be hands free with the exception of the toilets.
- All washrooms have a limit of 2 players per washroom and **mask MUST be worn when entering the building.**
- Please follow good hygiene practices when using the washroom

## On the golf course

- All **GOLF CARTS** must adhere to **90 degree rule** unless otherwise directed.
- Ball Washers, benches, divot repair boxes have been restored.
- At this time, bunker rakes are still not available. This is a course decision due to some people's hesitancy to touch objects that are not being sanitized after every use. In short, if people are not going to use the rakes then preferred lies are going to be needed anyways. So please continue to smooth the sand with your foot/club and use preferred lies.
- The Back and Blue tee blocks have been restored.
- Gimme's are encouraged.
- Keeping the pin in the hole is still encouraged.
- The use of hand sanitizer after each hole is recommended.
- As always, replace divots, repair ball marks and adhere to all signage

## RENTALS

- Club Rentals are available.
- **Pull Carts are allowed.** Please leave the handle attached when finished, so that it can be disinfected and washed
- **Power Carts are allowed.** **MASK ARE NO LONGER NEEDED** in a power cart. When finished, please discard or your garbage and leave your power cart on the front patio to be cleaned and sanitized.

## Pace of Play

- To avoid gatherings out on the course due to slow play AND fast play, all players must play at a 4 hour to 4 hour 30 minute pace for 18 holes as recommended by the G.A.O. (*2 hours to 2 hours 15 minutes for 9 holes*)
- This means players will have 13 minutes to 15 minutes to play each hole
- Any players playing slower or faster will be encouraged to change their pace of play.
- Other measures may be taken if any group is not compliant.
- Slower groups may be asked to pick up their ball and move to the next hole

## Food & Beverage | Restaurant

- Food and beverage can be purchased after checking in or on the turn from our service window located on the north side of the building (facing the 10<sup>th</sup> tee)
- **The beverage cart** is available on the course. Hours may vary. Debit or Credit is preferred. Cash is accepted.

## Want your food ready for pick up on the 10<sup>th</sup> hole or after your round?

- Look for our pre-order signs on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> tee.
- Debit and credit is preferred. Cash is accepted.
- **ALL ALCOHOL PURCHASED OFF-SITE IS PROHIBITED UNDER PROVINCIAL LAW.**

## Outside Patio

- No government limit per table
- All patrons are required to give contact information for contact tracing
- All tables have been placed 6 feet apart.
- **Hours of Operation:** Monday to Friday: 10am to 8pm, Saturday, Sunday and Holidays: 9am to 8pm

## Booking Tee Times

- Tee times can be booked by contacting the Proshop or booking online at [www.bellevuegolf.ca](http://www.bellevuegolf.ca)
- Debit and credit is preferred. Cash is accepted.
- When necessary, twosomes or singles will be paired up.

## Driving Range

- **The driving range and putting green is reserved ONLY for those who have purchased a basket of balls.** Players with tee times can use the practice green next to the first tee once checked in.
- **Hours of Operation:** Range baskets can be purchased between the hours of 7am to 8pm on Saturday, Sunday & Holidays, 8am to 8pm Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday or 10am to 8pm Monday and Thursday. Hours of operation are subject to change due to weather, sunrise and sunset
- **Bucket Sizes:** Small, Medium and Large.
- Range Buckets can be purchased through our service window for the turn facing the 10<sup>th</sup> tee. **Before 11am range buckets must be purchased from our service window facing the parking lot**
- **Once finished, all players must place their range baskets in the designate pail for sanitization.**

## Tee Times and Driving Range

- Players with tee times can use the driving range during the hours of operation listed above. **Please follow check-in protocols.**
- All players can use the driving range until 15 minutes before their scheduled tee time.
